CORE VALUES	VALUE TRANSLATED INTO A GUIDING PRINCIPLE STATEMENT Express the value in terms of what you are going to do about it.
Family <i>Solid Foundation to be free</i>	Sarah and my boys are the solid ground from which I walk. They remind me every day what love, compassion, loyalty, and passion are. <i>They are everything on this earth.</i>
Faith <i>Walk the Walk</i>	Walk with God brings fulfillment, humility, and a servant to my community. I need to commit to learn, to participant, and to serve. <i>I will do my best to walk the walk.</i>
Health Freedom to be Active	I need to be active in taking care of my body. Being healthy and strong allows me to be active with my wife and kids. <i>Living to be Active.</i>
Friendship <i>Sharing with brothers</i>	Being and sharing with brothers a connection of your own choice, commitments and relationships that are real and without disguise. <i>Living in Brotherhood</i>
Financial <i>Freedom with Security</i>	The freedom and security of having solid finances. Providing for those that I love, giving back to God and community. <i>Living to be secure and giving</i>
Learning <i>Freedom to Grow</i>	Constantly challenging one to improve and be the best person that I can be for those around me and myself. <i>Living for Growth and Engagement</i>
<i>Freedom with Life</i>	The world is a wondrous place of beauty, people, culture, and history. Building memories and experience what this world has to offer. <i>Living to Explore</i>
